Day 1. Arrival - Wakiso District

Upon arrival at Entebbe International Airport, you will proceed to clear with immigration and custom formalities. Thereafter, met by a Liberty Africa Safari's representative and transferred to The Boma Guest house Entebbe.

Day 2. Kibale

This day we drive to Kibale Forest Reserve via Mityana and Fort Portal, in a breathtaking landscape that forms the Albertine Western Rift Valley. We will have several stop overs to relax, and sightseeing as we pass verdant countryside, traditional homesteads and farms. We will have our packed/picnic lunch on the way. Check in and relax for the rest of the evening.

Day 3. Kibale – Chimp trek

Kibale Forest National park is the famous home of the largest concentration of chimpanzees in Africa, as well as a bewildering variety of other primates, birds and butterflies. Today you enter the forest in search of the cheeky chimpanzees as well as other primates. Later go for a swamp walk in Bigodi. Return to the lodge for overnight.

Day 4. Queen Elizabeth

Depart after breakfast, drive via Kasese to Queen Elizabeth National Park, and check in at Kasenyi Safari Camp.

Late afternoon game drives returning to the lodge before dusk for dinner and overnight.

Day 5. Queen Elizabeth

In the early morning we do a game drive in Kasenyi area, within Queen Elisabeth NP, on a look out for the lions, buffalos, elephants, and large numbers of Uganda Kobs and other antelopes. After we will go back to the lodge for breakfast, and relax until lunch time. At 1400 hours, we will go for a boat cruise on the Kazinga Channel (2 hours approx.), to look out for the hippos, great herds of buffaloes, and lots of water birds.

Day 6. Queen Elizabeth – Ishasha Sector

After breakfast, drive to Ishasha sector of the park, famous for its tree climbing lions that can sometimes be spotted resting in the branches of the large fig trees in the area. Check in at Ishasha Jungle Lodge for lunch. Late afternoon game drives returning before dusk, freshen-up ready for dinner and overnight.

Day 7. Bwindi Impenetrable Forest Reserve

After an early breakfast, depart to Bwindi Impenetrable NP, home of the endangered mountain gorilla. Arrive at your camp which is located deep within Bwindi Impenetrable Forest, a UNESCO World Heritage Site in southwest Uganda. Arriving in the late afternoon, spend the evening at leisure.

Day 8. Bwindi Impenetrable Forest Reserve - gorilla trek

After breakfast take a short transfer to Bwindi NP headquarters. Bwindi Impenetrable Forest impresses with a truly theatrical landscape - this is a region of volcanoes, jagged valleys, waterfalls, lakes and dramatic mountain ranges. Here you will meet up with excellent local guides/rangers and trackers, who will give a talk on the etiquette of gorilla trekking. Thereafter, hike into the forest with your packed lunch. Return to the camp/lodge and spend the afternoon/evening at leisure.

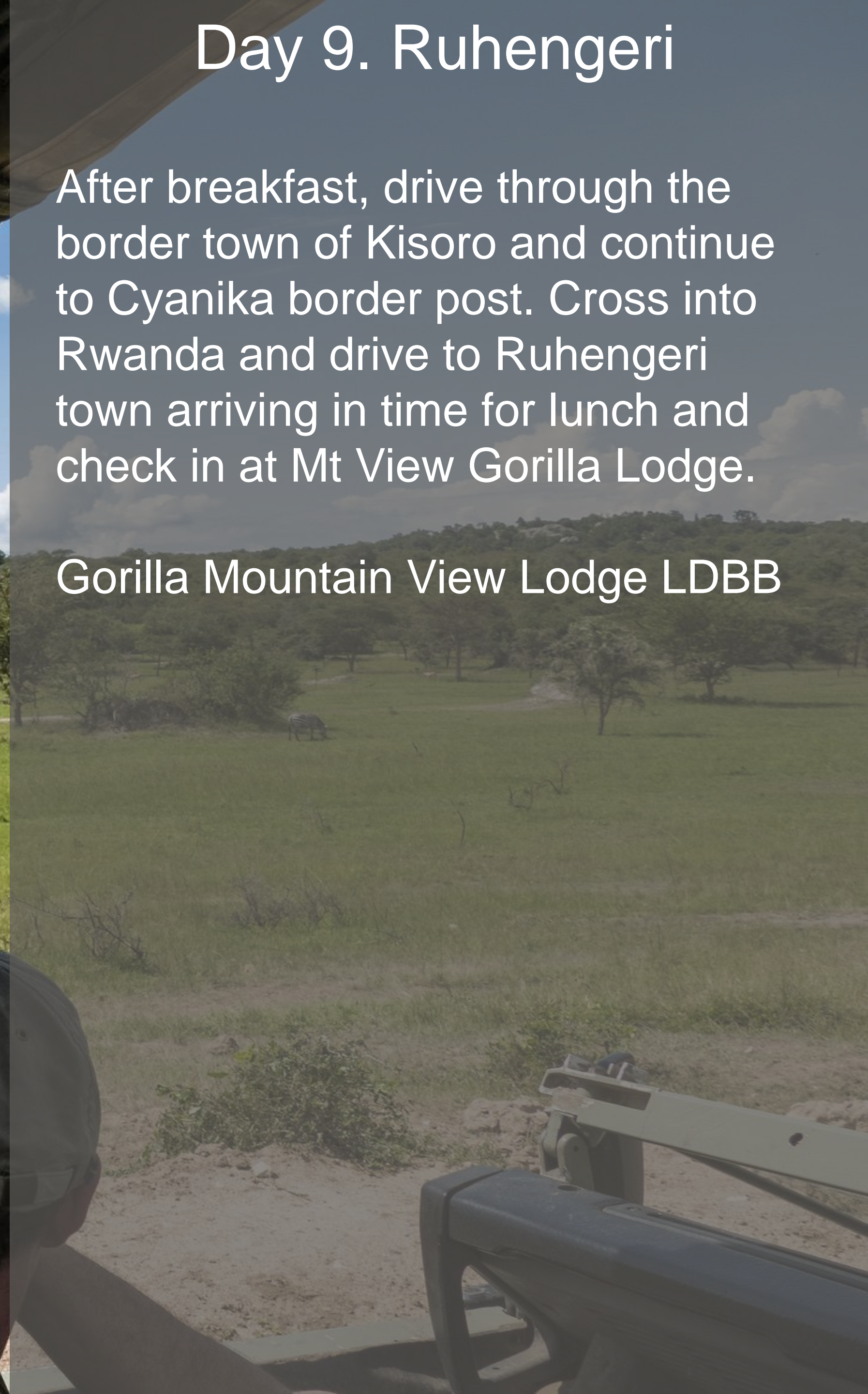




Day 9. Ruhengeri

After breakfast, drive through the border town of Kisoro and continue to Cyanika border post. Cross into Rwanda and drive to Ruhengeri town arriving in time for lunch and check in at Mt View Gorilla Lodge.

Day 10. Ruhengeri - 2nd Gorilla trek

Early breakfast at your lodge; 0630 hours; Transfer to the Volcanoes National Park HQs; 0700 hours; Registration where the park staff determines which group of gorillas you will visit. Trekking can take from two to six or more hours if the gorillas move before the park rangers locate them the next morning. The guides stop frequently to allow trekkers a chance to rest and take photos along the way. After the trek, meet up with your guide and transfer back to your lodge for lunch/dinner and overnight.

Day 11. Ruhengeri

Early breakfast at your lodge 0630 hours; Transfer to the Volcanoes National Park HQs at 0700 hrs: Registration at the Volcanoes National Park Offices; optional activities include; Gorilla trek, Golden Monkeys trek, trek to Dian Fossey grave. Later return to the lodge, afternoon at leisure.

Day 12. Kigali

After breakfast, transfer to Kigali, drive South past coffee, tea and banana plantations on a breathtaking scenic drive to Kigali. Lunch in Kigali. Time permitting go for city tour of Kigali including a visit to the genocide museum and later transfer to the airport for your international flight.

Hotel – The Boma Entebbe

Hotel – Kibale Forest Camp

Hotel – Kasenyi Safari Camp

- Strategically located on the rim of lake Bunyampaka in the Kasenyi savannah of Queen Elizabeth National Park. Many animals frequent the camp during day & at night
